## ALL-TERRAIN-VEHICLE (ATV) ORDINANCE #01-01

---

**Amendment of 5/24/2001 adding b, c & d to #1**

**Amendment of 4/14/10 adding e and f to Paragraph 1, amending Paragraph 1a and Paragraph 9 and correcting language.**

The Town Board of the Town of Spider Lake does ordain as follows:

1. That portions of the following named roads in the Town of Spider Lake shall be designated as All-Terrain-Vehicle (ATV) routes as part of the Sawyer County ATV Trail System, between those areas posted as such with ATV signs:
  - a. Rock Lake Road (from the intersection of Trail 8 and Rock Lake Road to the Bayfield County Line)
  - b. Janet Road from Lenroot Town Line to Bodecker Rd. .36 miles
  - c. Bodecker Road from Lenroot Town Line to Janet Road intersection. .19 miles
  - d. Telemark Road from Bayfield County Line to Camp #38 Road. .5 miles
  - e. Fire Tower Road from the Bayfield County Line to Camp #38 road, approximately 55 feet.
  - f. Lake Helane Road – 1.2 miles from intersection of Lake Helane Road and Preston Road and .6 miles from the intersection of Telemark Road and Lake Helane Road, approximately 810 feet.
2. The speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour while operating on a Town of Spider Lake ATV Route.
3. ATV's shall operate on the extreme right side of the roadway and travel with the flow of traffic.
4. ATV's are to be operated in single file.
5. ATV operators shall yield right-of-way to all other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
6. Headlights shall be turned on and in working order at all times while operating on a designated ATV Route.
7. Operators of ATV's violating any of the above conditions are subject to the underlying violation of illegally operating on the roadway.
8. Operators of ATV's travel at their own risk and the Town of Spider Lake will not be liable for any damages or injuries to operators of ATV's occurring in the Town of Spider Lake.
9. This ordinance may be enforced by any law enforcement officer authorized to enforce the laws of the State of Wisconsin.
10. The penalties for violating any of the provisions of this ordinance are the same as listed in S 23.33, Wis. Stats., and are adopted by reference.
11. This ordinance shall be effective for one year from the date of enactment and shall lapse unless re-authorized by the Town Board.
12. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting as provided by law and shall repeal and/or replace all ATV route ordinances heretofore enacted by the Town of Spider Lake.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage by the Town of Spider Lake Town Board and pursuant to appropriate publication or posting as required by law.
