



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE, SAWYER CO, WI
ANNUAL TOWN MEETING - 04/13/2010**

The Town of Spider Lake Annual Town meeting of the Electors was called to order by the Town Chair Brian Hucker. Ten electors, which included six elected officials, were present. Supervisor Meyer was absent.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the Annual Town Meeting held 4-14-09 were reviewed. Motion to approve the minutes was made by Dolores Brandt and seconded by Carol Alcoe. All in Favor. Motion carried.

Chairman Hucker gave a brief preliminary financial report for 2009 and budget for 2010 stating that these are not final numbers. There may be some slight adjustments made between 2009 and 2010 due to allocating tax revenues to the right calendar year. The final report will be available on the web site and also at the Town Hall. Revenues for 2009 came in slightly higher than budgeted. Disbursements were under budget. The surplus may be used for one of three things: reserve fund for capital equipment, other capital reserve account, or to reduce future taxes.

Carol Alcoe asked how the lake monitoring money is used. Chairman Hucker advised the Town has a cooperative arrangement with Spider Chain of Lakes Association. Grant money received by the Town is used to hire and pay monitors. The deficit between what the Town receives and what the monitors are paid is picked up by the Lake Association. Although no formal notice has been received, it appears that the Town has received a three year 50-50 grant from the DNR for lake monitoring.

It was announced that a Road Committee meeting will be held on 5-4-10 to discuss major road projects, assessment of equipment and smaller road projects which were created by ice being on the roads for a long period of time this winter.

The Board budgeted \$1,000.00 for donations. A motion was made by Kay Hucker to donate \$250.00 each to the Spider Lake Cemetery and the Hayward Food Shelf. Seconded by Dolores Brandt. After discussion, the motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Clerk Guyer asked if the Town could have a collection for florescent bulbs. Supervisor Brandt will look into that.

Dolores Brandt stated the 25th Annual Spider Lake Volunteer Fire Department Chicken BBQ will be held July 11th this year. The picnic starts at 11:00 AM and the music will be provided by the Namekagon String Band. Final payment for the current fire truck will be made this year.

Dolores Brandt announced there was a fire on FR204. She will be billing the Forest Service for the Fire Department's assistance.

Kay Hucker asked whether there has been any effect on the community now that there is an ambulance stationed in Round Lake. Delores Brandt & Kathy Overman advised that it has improved response time.

Carol Alcoe commended Road Supervisor McGuiness and the road crew on a job well done.

Clerk Guyer advised the newly elected Town Officers had signed their oaths and were officially sworn in.

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Chairman Hucker asked Carol Alcoe to announce in the newspaper the Town still needs a Plan Commission Secretary.

Motion to adjourn the Annual Town Meeting was made by Ruth Guyer. Seconded by Dolores Brandt. All in Favor. Motion carried.
