



**TOWN OF SPIDER LAKE
ROAD COMMITTEE MEETING 7-19-11**

The Town of Spider Lake Road Committee meeting was called to order by Supervisor McGuiness at 1:03 p.m. Present were McGuiness, Hucker, Brandt and Dennis Diem.

Summer Road Projects

Hucker advised there is approximately \$91,000.00 remaining in the budget for summer road projects. However, some funds may need to be reallocated to cover projected fuel and supply costs for the balance of the year. After discussion, a motion was made by Hucker and 2nd by Brandt to advertise for bids for 6,000 yards of gravel and to advertise for bids to reconstruct, ditch, gravel and grade approximately 1.85 miles of Rock Lake Road. All in favor. Motion carried. The estimated cost of the gravel is under \$35,000.00. The estimated cost of the Rock Lake Road project is under \$32,000.00. Bids will be opened at the town board meeting on 8-10-11. The DNR will be contacted to see if the town needs any permits for road work on Lake Helene Road.

Discussion was held regarding the use of AC cement to crack seal the separations on portions of Balsam Road at an estimated cost of \$2,500.00 to \$5,000.00.

Plow for Utility Truck

McGuiness advised the plow for the new utility truck has not arrived. The town may have to look elsewhere for the plow if it is not delivered soon.

Logging

Discussion was held regarding the effects logging has on the town roads. Permits are now needed for temporary logging roads. Hucker will check with other towns to determine if permits are required for loggers to use roads.

Backhoe

Repairs to the tractor with the backhoe were discussed. The estimated cost of repair is under \$5,000.00. Diem will check on hauling. A motion was made by Hucker and 2nd by McGuiness to proceed with the repairs to the backhoe. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Hucker and 2nd by McGuiness. All in favor. Motion carried.
